Trivia Answer

The summer of 1971 saw the introduction of this diminutive Cat. It was Kawasaki powered until 1976, which then saw the switch to Suzuki power plants. Originally priced at \$399, the early models are now collector items. The Kitty Cat remained virtually without competition until the 1998 Ski-Doo MiniZ appeared at dealers. Numbers are hard to come by but an estimated 40,000 of these cats were put into the hands of kids across the snow belt.


