'Track N Trails' The 68 T'NT had a 600cc fan cooled vertical twin with two carbs in a "V" shape. The 600cc engine was the first engine Rotax made specifically for a Ski-Doo. The 68 T'NT is a very rare sled because Bombardier only produced 125 of these Ski-Doo. Two models were produced for 1969, a 399cc and a 669cc machine. In 1970 the line was expanded to 5 models. Also, an optional slide suspension was offered for an additional \$20.00. 1978 was the last year for the T'NT.
